



City of Madison Fire Department SHIFT EXPLANATION

The computer program required by the federal government for the *National Fire Incident Reporting System (NFIRS)* permits the designation of "shifts" or time periods in which to record incidents.

This is useful for developing data as to the time of day in which certain types of incidents occur. For example, do the majority of incidents, including fires, in one and two family dwellings, happen late at night when the occupants would be asleep? This is just one sample of the type of information that can be drawn from the data base. All data is sent to the Office of State Fire Marshal on a monthly basis, and that office sends it on to the federal government.

The MFD shifts designations are:

- 1 Midnight 07:59 A.M., Monday thru Friday.
- 2 Midnight 07:59 A.M., Saturday thru Sunday.
- 3 08:00 A.M. 4:00 P.M., Monday thru Friday.
- 4 08:00 A.M. 4:00 P.M., Saturday thru Sunday.
- 5 04:01 P.M. 11:59 P.M., Monday thru Friday.
- 6 04:01 P.M. 11:59 P.M., Saturday thru Sunday.
